Infrastructure Purpose and Rationale		
<p>Part of this grant will be used for the installation of a storm water pump station, known as Storm Water Pump Station #3, in the Mission Bay community that will handle the storm water run-off for the basin of the surrounding area. The facility will replace and modify the existing storm water pump station and outfall structure which currently handles wet weather flows in the surrounding residential areas.</p> <p>This infrastructure provides long term economic benefits by facilitating additional development activity, including the estimated \$80.5 million construction of 150 units of affordable housing and the estimated \$5.4 million development of 1.5 acres of parks and open space that serve these units, all of which depend on this pump station to handle their storm water flows. The infrastructure investment also is part of a larger overhaul of infrastructure at Mission Bay that eliminates antiquated infrastructure and modernizes the water infrastructure to meet the needs of the future. The project will be funded through a combination of CDBG-R, State and local funds.</p>
