**Award Description\***

The Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) is a \$7,739,300 formula grant from U.S. Department of Energy under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) to fund the Municipal Building Energy Efficiency Retrofit, the Community Resilience, and the Heating Systems Programs. This grant will additionally provide initial seed money for San Francisco's Clean Energy Loan Program. The Municipal Building Energy Efficiency Retrofit program will be managed by the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) and implemented by the Department of Public Works (DPW). The Community Resilience and Heating Systems Programs will be managed by the San Francisco Department of Environment (SFE).

During the quarter (July 1, 2009 to Sept 30, 2009), SFPUC received the award (8/17/2009) and prepared information for the accept and expend process. The SFPUC Commission adopted a resolution on September 8, 2009 to accept and expend the \$7,739,300. Currently accept and expend legislation is pending the Board of Supervisors, which is part of the required City approval process. Once approved by the full Board, this legislation will be forwarded to the Mayor for final signature. That approval is currently anticipated in the second quarter of FY 2009-10 (Oct-Dec).
