This grant will additionally provide initial seed money for San Francisco's Clean Energy Loan Program. The Municipal Building Energy Efficiency Retrofit program will be managed by the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) and implemented by the Department of Public Works (DPW). The Community Resilience and Heating Systems Programs will be managed by the San Francisco Department of Environment (SFE).</p> | | |
