Award Description*

This application is for the 1880 Pine and 1760 Bush sites, within Westside Courts Project, AMP 956. The 1880 Pine site contains 113 dwelling units for seniors and persons with disabilities. The 1760 Bush site contains 108 dwelling units for seniors and persons with disabilities. The \$3,995,994 in CFRC grant funds will be used to fund additional energy-saving and green improvements as part of the moderate rehabilitation of these sites. An additional \$2,508,858 in Green improvements will be completed as part of the authority's Energy Services Contract and provides 62.7843% Leverage for the CFRC funds being requested. Once these improvements have been completed, this Project (AMP) and all of its 564 units, will become the Authority's first AMP to adopt Green policies for all of its ongoing maintenance and capital projects as detailed in this narrative. As part of this moderate modernization program, SFHA has developed and documented a strategy that will provide substantial savings in energy/water consumption. Completion of the window replacement and the energy conservation improvements listed below will result in a 42% reduction in energy use and a 32% reduction in water usage at the 1880 Pine site. The total savings at 1880 Pine will be 39%. Th
