**Award Description\***

The Rosa Parks site contains, with 198 dwelling units for seniors/persons with disabilities, and a separate senior center community facilities building. The \$2,780,755 in CFRC grant funds will be used for three activity types and address the needs of the elderly along with those persons with disabilities, through improvements to the Rosa Parks public housing units, indoor and outdoor non-dwelling areas, and the Rosa Parks Senior Center community facilities building. Activity 1. Nine dwelling units in Rosa Parks which are currently out of compliance with UFAS will be modified to make them fully accessible with roll-in showers in accordance with the UFAS.. Activity 3. Improvements will be made to non-dwelling areas inside the property as well as the exterior pathways and open areas between the housing building and the Senior Center building to make them accessible and ADA-compliant. The outdoor area surrounding the senior center and the current path of travel from the public housing to the senior center are not accessible; accessibility improvements will include ramps and handrails, landings, parking, paving, and landscaping. The three elevator cars within Rosa Parks public housing are not accessible; accessibility improvements will be made to the dir
